Hanley Environment Group Notes and actions

Meeting on Monday 9 December 2024. Participants: Malcolm Fare, Sue Adeney, Biddi Kings, Janet Lomas, Jackie Bass, Steve Pennant, Suzanne Bennett.

- 1. The Group welcomed Steve Pennant onto the committee.
- 2. <u>Footpaths</u>: Welland are in the process of building a circular footpath around the village; **ACTION: SB** to contact Mark Whaley re a site visit. SP and BK to join the visit
- 3. <u>Trees</u>: We have around 100 saplings, and the offer of more provided by Wayne Bridges in the village. More are due but rain has delayed them: due in January. MF leading
 - 6th form alley (alongside the Glebe): School operations management/Groundsman leads on this. May use some of the above trees
 - <u>Church End bulb planting:</u> The Groundsman will order bulbs in bulk for planting at the end of 2025, using funds from this f/y. These bulbs will be interspersed with the wildflower areas and the preparatory work will be done this f/y. **ACTION** JL.
 - <u>Coppicing:</u> We discussed a possible early 2025 event: **ACTION SA** to enquire about a contact to demonstrate coppicing: Possibly Steve Rowitt.
 - contact at Hellens in Much Marcle re hurdle making: ACTION BK
 - <u>Black Poplars:</u> these are rare, and are a flood plain tree. They can be pollarded.
 Castle Morton have saplings. **ACTION JB** re details of rstock to plant.
 - <u>Street Trees:</u> SA working with Worcs County Council. We agreed residents need a voice in where they are planted/their maintenance. We agreed to produce an article in the Parish Link & content on our social media channels. **ACTION SA**
 - To raise awareness that large trees are part of the street scene, ACTION MF to write and article for the Parish Link with support from SA
 - <u>Severn Trent Grant</u>: Hedging: The Hanleys have received funding for orchard and woodland planting in 2024 for 6 sites. The next planting day is Tuesday 14 January 2025. **ACTION MF** to approach Welland and Castle Morton to ask if they would like to bid into the fund.
- 4. Water Quality: no reply yet: ACTION MF to contact Dave Johnson at the Rivers Trust.
- 5. Ebikes:
- Cycling with Confidence course to promote this again in spring 25: ACTION SA
- General promotion to begin again in the spring: ACTION SB ccSA
- Storage: **ACTION SB** to approach Sarah Darwent at Albion Lodge
- E-bike User Trial forms: **ACTION SB** to collect from Albion Lodge for 4 people who have trialled the ebikes
- ACTION SA to get a form from Pippa Barclay
- Both bikes will need a service: **ACTION SB** to arrange in January/ before end of f/y.
- 6 <u>Insulation</u>: insulation at the Village Hall: SP to contact contact Graham Holmes at Guarlford.
- 7 EV charging: There are EV chargers at Hanley Castle High School (4) and Albion Lodge, **ACTION SB** to ask if we can promote their use to villagers and to get more details.
- 8 <u>Flood mitigation</u>: the survey we participated in for Earth Watch revealed 84% of the water courses had poor water quality. We will take part in the spring survey Action Malcolm Fare to coordinate. **ACTION MF/SP**: Results to be posted on the website.
